## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## January 1, 2025

- Q. What are my voting rights in the condominium association?
- A. Each unit is entitled to cast one vote. In the event a unit is owned by more than one individual, the owners must designate one voting representative by a written certificate.
- Q. What restrictions exist in the condominium documents on my right to use my unit?
- A. Use is for residential purposes only. No age restrictions. Refer to the rules and regulations the Board of Directors has adopted and the condominium documents.
- Q. What restrictions exist in the condominium documents or rules on the leasing of my unit?
- A. No unit owner may lease his unit for three years after purchasing. The required credit score of all persons on the lease is 700 or higher and there is a minimum income requirement. The monthly rental amount cannot exceed 30% of the total income of all persons on the lease. No felony convictions. Leases must be a minimum of 4 months and no more than 12 months. One lease per calendar year is allowed.
- Q. How much are my monthly assessments for my type unit? And when are they due?
- A. Type A Unit \$760.30, B Unit \$779.30, C Unit \$971.95. Due on the 1st of each month. A late fee of \$25 applies after 7 days.
- Q. Do I have to be a member of any other association and what is the fee?
- A. Yes, Boca Del Mar Improvement Association. Yearly fee of \$168.00 is included in your Camino Real Village Association maintenance fees.
- Q. Am I required to pay rent or land use fees for recreational or other facilities? A. No
- Q. Is the condominium association or other mandatory membership association involved in any court case in which it may face liability in excess of \$100,000?
